# Italian companies have invested USD 6.5 billion in India: Lorenzo Tavazzi

Mumbai, Nov 29 (PTI) - The European House Ambrosetti group's senior partner Lorenzo Tavazzi on Friday said Italian companies have invested USD 6.5 billion in India, which speaks of the importance accorded to the world's fastest growing major economy, and stressed that there are a lot of opportunities for growth.

Tavazzi, who heads TEHA's Scenarios and Intelligence Areas, was speaking in Mumbai after the inauguration of the Villaggio Italia exhibition, being held to coincide with the port of call of Ameglio Vespucci, an Italian Navy ship used for training and supporting national diplomacy.

## BEST aims to have more than 50 pc e-buses in fleet by 2025-26; plans to have 1200 e-double deckers

(Standard Post Bureau) Mumbai, Nov 29 - The civic-run Brihanmumbai Electric Supply and Transport (BEST) undertaking wants its fleet to have more than 50 per cent electric buses by 2025-26 and then raise the number to 8,000 in the subsequent years. In a release issued during the day, the metropolis' premier road transport undertaking said it has set an ambitious goal to have 100 per cent zero-emission electric bus fleet by 2026-27.

An order has been placed for 2,650 single-decker electric buses, it added.

On Thursday, BEST general manager Anil Diggikar presented the undertaking's Rs 9439.56 crore budget to Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation commissioner and administrator Bhushan Gagrani for 2025-26.

"In the Rs 1 lakh surplus budget, BEST's estimated deficit is of Rs 2086.33 crore, as its electric supply wing is estimated to get a profit of Rs 46.18 crore, but the transport wing is estimated to face a deficit of Rs 2131.51 crore. Capital expenditure for 2025-26 is expected to be Rs 1849.24 crore, while showing an expected Rs 2812.03 crore grant from its parent BMC during the financial year," the release said.

BEST needs Rs 679.51 crore for filling the gap in its capital expenditure, the release pointed out. "Currently, BEST has a fleet of 3,166 buses, including 2,081 hired vehicles and zero-emission e-buses. There are plans to buy 273 big-sized and 237 mid-sized air-conditioned single-decker e-buses as well as scrapping 520 self-owned buses that will complete their 'coidal-life span'," the release said.

## Within 24 hours, Govt withdraws grants released for state Waqf board

Mumbai Nov 29 (UNI) - Within 24 hours after releasing Rs 10 crore for the state Waqf Board, the Maharashtra government on Friday cancelled the same, saying a caretaker government cannot release pre-approved funds.

The decision comes amid opposition to the grant by Hindu groups and the question about a caretaker government issuing such an order.

On Thursday, the Minority Development Department of the state government issued a resolution allocating Rs 10 crore to the State Waqf Board for the financial year 2024-25.

The fund was intended to enhance the board's infrastructure and management. The allocation was part of a broader budgetary provision of Rs 20 crore for the Waqf Board, with Rs 2 crore disbursed earlier in June.

A demand for an additional Rs 10 crore was raised via a letter dated August 23 with the department. Based on that letter, Rs 10 crore was released on Thursday.

Chief Secretary Sujita Saunik clarified that a caretaker government cannot release pre-approved funds.

"We do not have a full-time government as of now. This is a caretaker government which has no power to release the amount," she said.

"The amount should have been released before the implementation of the Model Code of Conduct (MCC). And even though the MCC is lifted now, we still have a caretaker government. The concerned officials failed to realise this due to a lack of knowledge of rules," Saunik said.

She added that once a full government is in place, then the necessary action can be taken regarding the money.

The decision to release the grant faced immediate backlash from opposition parties and Hindu organisations. Shiv Sena (UBT), led by Uddhav Thackeray, criticised the grant, calling it a "politically motivated" attempt to consolidate minority votes.

Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Priyanka Chaturvedi labelled the move as "hypocrisy" and questioned the caretaker government's authority to make such policy decisions. Party leader Sanjay Raut also remarked on the irony of the government making such a grant.

## Ashtalakshmi Mahotsav to be held from December 6-8 at Bharat Mandapam

New Delhi, Nov 29 (UNI) : A three-day Ashtalakshmi Mahotsav of the North-Eastern States would be organised at the Bharat Mandapam in the national capital from December 6, 2024.
