

Minister, Chandrakant Patil calls for united effort to make Sangli drug-free

Sangli, Aug 24 (UNI) : Higher and Technical Education Minister and Sangli Guardian Minister Chandrakant Patil has called for a united effort to make the district drug-free, urging people to resolve to break the chains of addiction and protect the younger generation.

Speaking at a programme organised to mark the conclusion of the "Nashamukti Nirdhar Padyatra" organised under

the Drug-Free Sangli District campaign, Patil said the top priority of Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis and the state government was to prevent the youth from being drawn into drug abuse and safeguard their future.

Patil said that after he assumed charge as the district Guardian Minister, drugs worth around Rs 30 crore were seized in Vita. Against the backdrop of growing concern over drug

abuse in the district, he said the administration had launched a campaign to make Sangli drug-free.

The campaign is based on three key pillars; administrative action and prevention, public awareness, and counselling, he said.

"Despair and emptiness lead to addiction," Patil said, stressing the need for greater involvement of schools and teachers in preventing substance

abuse among students.

He urged teachers to encourage students to participate in activities such as music, dance, acting and stick fighting, saying the government would bear the expenses involved in providing such training.Patil called on citizens to join the campaign and work collectively to break the cycle of addiction and ensure a safer future for the youth of Sangli.

Mumbai Gymnastics instructor booked under POCSO act for sexually harassing minor

Mumbai, Aug 24 (UNI) A 48-year-old gymnastics instructor has been booked by the Vile Parle Police following a complaint by a 16-year-old student, who alleged that she was sexually harassed by him at a gymnasium, police said on Monday.

According to police, the minor had been undergoing gymnastics training under the accused who is also a Dronacharya awardee for several years. She is reportedly a college student.Based on her complaint, the police registered an FIR against the coach under relevant provisions of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS).

Police have initiated an investigation into the allegations and are recording statements of the complainant and other persons associated with the matter.Further details regarding the circumstances of the alleged incident and the subsequent police action are awaited.

The allegations are under investigation, and the accused's version, if any, is yet to be ascertained.

40 hospitalised after Chlorine Gas leak at Nagpur water treatment plant

Nagpur, Aug 24 (UNI) More than 40 people were hospitalised following a chlorine gas leak from a water treatment plant in the Godhni Gram Panchayat area of Nagpur district, official sources said on Monday.

According to preliminary reports, the leakage occurred around 0100 hours on Sunday from a 900-kg chlorine gas cylinder at the Godhani Nagar Panchayat's water treatment plant near Fago Patil Layout and Nag Mandir Tekdi.

As the toxic gas drifted into adjoining residential

areas, several residents complained of coughing and respiratory distress, prompting authorities to initiate an immediate evacuation as a precautionary measure.

Personnel from the Nagpur Municipal Corporation's Fire and Emergency Services rushed to the site and shifted residents from the affected areas to safer locations.

Officials said approximately eight to 10 plant employees and 20 to 25 residents were affected in the incident. Police said around 40 persons were

undergoing treatment at Sparsh Hospital and Mominpura Mayo Hospital.

A coordinated operation involving Orange City Water Works (OCW), the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) and the Nagpur Municipal Corporation was launched to contain the leakage and evacuate residents from the affected areas.The condition of those undergoing treatment was reported to be stable.Efforts to bring the situation fully under control were continuing, while further details were awaited.

Rahul Gandhi should introspect before talking about women's dignity: Dr Neelam Gorhe

Pune, Aug 24 (UNI) : Shiv Sena leader and Maharashtra Legislative Council member Dr Neelam Gorhe on Monday criticised the Congress, saying the party should first introspect over objectionable remarks and incidents involving women by its leaders and workers before claiming to champion women's dignity and empowerment.

Gorhe said respect for women was not merely a political slogan but a social and constitutional responsibility.

Referring to the 1993 Tandoor case in Delhi, Gorhe underlined the responsibility of political parties towards women's safety.She also referred to the 2014 Kalpana Giri case

in Latur, mentioning serious allegations against individuals from political circles associated with the Congress and the punishment awarded to the accused.

Gorhe also questioned the Congress over several alleged incidents and remarks, including a Congress leader in Madhya Pradesh referring to women as "maal" (commodity), an alleged attempt by a party functionary to hug a woman Congress MLA during a felicitation programme in South India, and an alleged insensitive remark by a Congress MLA in Karnataka regarding r a p e . C o n d e m n i n g Congress leader Adhir Ranjan Chowdhury's reference to President

Droupadi Murmu as "Rashtrapatni", Gorhe said the remark amounted not merely to an insult to an individual but to disrespect for a constitutional office. She also questioned the Congress over its opposition to Droupadi Murmu's candidature for the presidency.

Referring to crimes against women during the tenure of the Congress government in Rajasthan and then Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot's reported remark that "boys make mistakes", Gorhe said there was a need to change the approach towards crimes and atrocities against women.Gorhe also criticised the Congress over its position on the rights of Muslim women.

She alleged that following the Shah Bano case, the Congress government had taken the initiative to enact legislation restricting the right to maintenance, thereby affecting the legitimate rights of Muslim women.

She further said that the Congress continued to oppose the Uniform Civil Code and had consistently taken positions that, according to her, were against ensuring equal rights and justice for women.Women's dignity is not a subject of politics but a social and constitutional responsibility.

No compromise can be accepted when it comes to the dignity of women. The Congress should first introspect, Dr Gorhe said

CM accuses MVA of stalling women's reservation to 2034

Mumbai, Aug 24 (UNI) : In a scathing political attack,Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Monday accused the Congress and the Maha Vikas Aghadi (MVA) alliance of deliberately adopting a regressive stance to stall the implementation of the Women's Reservation Bill.

Fadnavis claimed that while the opposition hypocritically supported the legislation in 2023

knowing it would pass, they are now manoeuvring to push the actual roll-out past 2029 and deep into 2034, indulging in calculated "intellectual confusion."During a comprehensive media interaction, the Chief Minister addressed multiple key governance and political developments:

Fadnavis countered senior Congress leader P. Chidambaram's remarks, highlighting that the 2023

legislation explicitly linked the quota's execution to fresh census data and subsequent delimitation. He asserted that Prime Minister Narendra Modi intended to enforce the quota by 2029, but the opposition rejected the necessary constitutional amendments and timelines, effectively trying to drag the matter out until 2034.

Clarifying the government's approach toward auto and taxi

drivers, Fadnavis emphasised that there is no forceful imposition or punitive agenda. The intent is merely to equip commercial drivers with functional, working knowledge of Marathi for commuter ease. Acknowledging extension requests, he assured that multi-generational residents and workers integrated into Mumbai's fabric will face no l a n g u a g e - b a s e d

discrimination.Highlighting agricultural welfare, the Chief Minister announced that under the Ahilyadevi Holkar Loan Waiver Scheme's second phase, Rs 5,086 crore has been directly disbursed to 6.36 lakh farmers. Combined across both phases, over 12.56 lakh farmers have received a total of Rs 10,115 crore, with additional incentives designated for regular loan payers following KYC completion.

Fadnavis should refrain from making needless statements: Congress's Gopal Tiwari

Pune, Aug 24 (UNI) : Spokesperson of state Congress Gopal Tiwari on Monday took a dig at Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis, urging him to "reduce his needless verbosity" and uphold the dignity of the Chief Minister's office while making allegations against the Opposition.

Reacting to Fadnavis' recent remarks against the Congress and its leader Rahul Gandhi over the issue of women's reservation, Tiwari said the Chief Minister's political compulsion to repeatedly criticise the Congress, allegedly to please Prime Minister Narendra Modi and union Home Minister Amit Shah, is quite understandable.

However, he said that Fadnavis appears to forget that he holds the office of Chief Minister and alleged that his remarks reflected "intellectual bankruptcy."

Tiwari said Fadnavis should be aware that the Women's Reservation Bill, providing for 33 per cent reservation for women, was passed by the Lok Sabha in September 2023 with near-unanimous support.

He claimed that the legislation does not mention that women's reservation cannot be implemented in the existing 543-member Lok Sabha until a delimitation exercise is completed.

"If Fadnavis is unaware of this, then why does he repeatedly display his intellectual bankruptcy by making the absurd claim that Congress is opposed to women's reservation?" Tiwari asked.

The Congress leader further said Fadnavis should explain to the BJP's top leadership that, according to him, the party's "anti-women face" has been exposed during the 2024 Lok Sabha elections, when the BJP

neither implemented women's reservation nor fielded a proportionate number of women candidates.

Of Maharashtra's 48 Lok Sabha seats, the Congress-led Maha Vikas Aghadi won 31, while the BJP-led Mahayuti secured 17 seats. Tiwari said Fadnavis should explain this reality to his speech-oriented leadership instead of repeatedly making illogical and misleading statements against Congress, Tiwari further added.

He urged Fadnavis to demonstrate greater ideological maturity and refrain from making statements that, he alleged, were misleading and factually incorrect.

Tiwari made the remarks in a statement issued in response to Fadnavis' comments concerning Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's position on women's policy and reservation.

MVA attacks Mahayuti over internal rifts, administrative lapses

Mumbai, Aug 24 (UNI) : Maharashtra NCP (Sharad Pawar faction) president Shashikant Shinde launched a sharp attack on the ruling Mahayuti government, accusing it of internal divisions, polarizing tactics, administrative failures and attempts to create social divisions for political gains.

Shinde said Maratha reservation activist Manoj Jarange-Patil was dissatisfied with the government after several assurances remained unfulfilled. He alleged that the Mahayuti was deliberately attempting to drive a wedge between communities to strengthen its political position.

Referring to recent administrative changes, including the reported empowerment of the Chief Minister to overrule decisions taken by other cabinet ministers, Shinde said the move reflected a lack of consensus within the ruling alliance and growing differences among its leaders.

He also criticised the government over a recent hospital incident in Amravati, saying that claims regarding safety measures remained confined to official paperwork. He demanded stringent legal action against those responsible for lapses.

On the issue of employment, Shinde alleged that young professionals were being offered low-value salary packages while changes in labour laws had weakened job security. He said the opposition would hold protests across the state, including regional demonstrations and submissions to local administrative authorities.

The opposition has announced statewide regional demonstrations, local administrative submissions, and an upcoming Unemployed Elgar Tiranga Rally on the 27th.

Condemning the aggressive deployment targets for smart utility meters despite previous assurances of non-compulsion, the NCP leader warned of intense public backlash over inflated utility bills.

Rohit Pawar seeks fire audit of all Govt hospitals after Amravati tragedy

Amravati, Aug 24 (UNI): NCP (SP) MLA Rohit Pawar on Monday demanded a comprehensive fire audit of all government hospitals across Maharashtra following the death of three newborns in a fire at the district women's hospital here.Pawar said the tragic incident should serve as a wake-up call for the authorities and stressed the need to ensure that all government hospitals are equipped with adequate fire-safety measures and

emergency preparedness.

Three newborns died after a fire broke out in the Special Newborn Care Unit (SNCU) of the district

women's hospital in Amravati early Monday. The blaze reportedly originated near a ventilator in the unit.

Bombay HC orders CBI probe into Disha Salian death, directs FIR registration

Mumbai, Sep 2 (UNI) The Bombay High Court on Wednesday directed the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) to undertake a comprehensive investigation into the death of Disha Salian, former manager of late actor Sushant Singh Rajput, who died after falling from the 14th floor of a residential building in suburban Malad in June 2020.

A bench headed by Justice Sarang Kotwal passed the order on a petition filed by Salian's father, Satish Salian, seeking an independent probe into his daughter's death and alleging that she had been assaulted and murdered. The court directed the senior CBI officer in charge of its Mumbai bureau to appoint an investigating officer,

who would record the petitioner's statement and register an FIR.

"The investigating officer shall conduct the investigation regarding all aspects surrounding the circumstances in which the petitioner's daughter lost her life," the bench directed. The court, however, made it clear that no individual shall be treated as an accused unless the investigating officer, on the basis of material gathered during the probe, finds sufficient grounds giving rise to reasonable suspicion against such a person.

The bench further directed that if the investigation establishes the commission of an offence, an appropriate report be placed before the

competent court. In the event no offence is made out, the CBI shall submit an appropriate summary, with the petitioner retaining the right to challenge such a report through a protest petition.

The court also ordered the Malwani Police Station to hand over all relevant documents, records and articles pertaining to the case to the CBI. In his petition, Salian alleged that his daughter's death was not accidental but was the result of rape and murder allegedly orchestrated to shield certain influential persons.

These allegations remain subject to investigation. The Maharashtra government has maintained that a preliminary inquiry by Mumbai Police had

indicated that Disha died by suicide.

Disha, 28, died on June 8, 2020, after falling from the high-rise building in Malad, six days before Sushant Singh Rajput was found dead at his Bandra residence on June 14. During the earlier hearings, the High Court scrutinised various circumstances surrounding Disha's death and sought clarifications from the government regarding details recorded in the panchnama.

The bench also examined photographs depicting her injuries and questioned whether they were consistent with a fall from the reported height. The government submitted that she had fallen on her face, sustaining a skull fracture, a serious jaw injury, and other injuries.

MPSC Chairman Vivek Bhimanwar clarifies stand on 'Drug Inspector' exam paper leak allegations

Mumbai, Sep 2 (UNI) Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPSC) Chairman Vivek Bhimanwar has issued a clarification regarding allegations against him in connection with the alleged leak of the "Drug Inspector" examination question paper, amid demands for his resignation. Bhimanwar said the incident took place in January 2026, whereas he was sworn in as MPSC chairman on February 18, and formally assumed charge on March 3. He therefore pointed out that the alleged paper leak had occurred before he took charge of the Commission. He, however, stressed that the MPSC has taken the matter seriously. A complaint has been filed in connection with the incident, following which the police have initiated an investigation.

To prevent the recurrence of such incidents, the Commission has constituted a high-level internal committee to examine the matter and recommend measures to strengthen the examination process. The state government has also appointed a high-level committee to suggest reforms and improvements in the examination system.

Furthermore, Bhimanwar maintained that serious allegations should be assessed strictly on the basis of facts, official records, and evidence.

He stated that the timing of the incident and the records concerning his appointment and assumption of charge should be taken into consideration while evaluating the allegations against him.

Supriya Sule attacks Govt as household budgets collapse under soaring costs

Mumbai, Sep 2 (UNI) Launching a scathing attack on the ruling administration over soaring household expenses, NCP (SP) working president Supriya Sule warned that runaway inflation has utterly shattered the financial stability of common families across Maharashtra.

Staging an aggressive protest outside the Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus (CSMT) alongside party workers, some wearing garlands of vegetables and grains to symbolize the crisis, Sule accused both central and state governments of turning a blind eye to public misery. Directing her criticism at policymakers, she challenged them to look

beyond government statistics and ask the women managing everyday households how severely the cost of living has escalated.

"Go home and ask your mother, sister, or wife how much inflation has grown," Sule said, emphasizing that essential items like milk, vegetables, onions, sugar, and grains have become increasingly unaffordable, choking the daily budgets of working-class families--from morning breakfast to evening meals.

The protest also trained its sights on flagship government initiatives. Sule questioned the current status of the state's Anandacha Shidha (festive ration scheme) and alleged that a vast

number of women's names have been quietly dropped from the Ladki Bahin welfare scheme following the conclusion of elections, leaving vulnerable families high and dry. Beyond urban households, the agitation highlighted deep agrarian distress, with Sule noting that farmers continue to face mounting debts despite official claims of robust economic growth. Referencing recent economic discourse, she contrasted government claims of high GDP growth with the stark reality faced by citizens, warning that the widening gap between macro economic data and ground-level survival demands immediate, concrete intervention rather than political rhetoric.

Maratha protesters block Dhule-Solapur Highway as Manoj Jarange-Patil's health deteriorates

Jalna, Sep 2 (UNI) : Tensions escalated in Antarwali Sarati on Wednesday as Maratha protesters blocked the Dhule-Solapur Highway following a deterioration in the health of activist Manoj Jarange-Patil, who is on the fifth day of an indefinite hunger strike demanding action on Maratha reservation and Kunbi certificate-related issues.

Jarange-Patil began his hunger strike on August 29 and has reportedly refused medical treatment. His condition deteriorated on Tuesday after he began suffering from vomiting, raising concerns among supporters gathered at the protest site.

A large number of Maratha protesters have

converged on Antarwali Sarati after learning about Jarange-Patil's worsening health. Long queues of vehicles were reported on both sides of the highway after protesters staged a sit-in and blocked traffic.

Some protesters allegedly placed wooden logs from nearby fields on the road, while others lay down on the highway to prevent vehicles from passing. Slogans were raised and the protesters adopted an aggressive stance, demanding that the government send its delegation to the protest site. Government officials have remained in contact with Jarange-Patil and have

been urging him to end his hunger strike. Officials have also briefed him about the steps being taken by the administration and changes made at the government level.

However, Jarange-Patil has reportedly insisted that a government delegation should personally visit Antarwali Sarati and hold discussions with him, rather than continuing negotiations through administrative officials.

The growing crowd and highway blockade have heightened tensions in the area. Police presence is likely to be strengthened to prevent the situation from escalating further.

CM sets six-month deadline to fill vacancies in tribal areas

Nagpur/Mumbai, Sept 2 (UNI): Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis has directed all government departments to expedite the recruitment process for vacant posts in tribal (PESA) areas and ensure that the exercise is completed within the next six months. Chairing a review meeting on Tuesday on vacancies in tribal regions, Fadnavis instructed departments to submit within two weeks comprehensive details of employees currently working against supernumerary posts, retired personnel in such positions, and the original sanctioned posts that remain vacant. The Chief Minister noted that several employees were shifted to

supernumerary posts after being relieved from their original positions in compliance with Supreme Court directives.

Considering their long years of service, the government had accommodated them on humanitarian grounds, he said. Fadnavis directed district collectors to immediately gather and verify department-wise data on supernumerary employees and corresponding vacancies. The information will be compiled and submitted to the Chief Secretary's office, following which departments will initiate the necessary recruitment mechanism to fill the vacant posts. Stressing the need for timely action, the Chief

Minister instructed all concerned departments to complete preparatory work within the prescribed period and made it clear that no extension would be granted to the recruitment deadline. The meeting also reviewed the status of verification of appointments made under the Scheduled Tribes (ST) category. Officials informed that a review in 2015 had revealed several employees had failed to submit caste validity certificates.

A subsequent verification exercise in 2019 identified around 6,860 employees without valid certificates, of whom 1,346 cases have since been resolved.

The issue of tribal vacancies has been a key

demand of ST organisations, which have been seeking immediate identification and filling of nearly 12,500 reserved posts across government departments and faster implementation of recruitment under the Panchayats (Extension to Scheduled Areas) Act (PESA). The government informed that recruitment has already been completed for nine of the 17 cadres, while the process for the remaining cadres will be initiated shortly.

Representatives also reiterated their demand for implementation of earlier government resolutions providing for placement of ST candidates at the second position in the government roster system.

Award for Maha energy dept for outstanding innovative design

Mumbai/New Delhi, Sept 2 (UNI) The Maharashtra energy department was conferred the award for its innovative staff design at the Energy Exhibition held as part of the Bharat Electricity, POWERGEN India and Indian Utility Week 2026 global conference in New Delhi on Wednesday. 'Over two crore voters deleted from Maha electoral rolls': Anjali Damania raises alarm

Mumbai, Sep 2 (UNI) Social activist Anjali Damania has raised serious concerns over the deletion of more than two crore names from Maharashtra's electoral rolls, alleging that nearly 21 per cent of voters have been removed from the lists.

In a strongly worded statement, Damania questioned how the names of such a large number of voters could disappear from the electoral rolls. She described it as a serious threat to democracy rather than merely an administrative error.

"Every fifth voter in Maharashtra has been pushed out of the electoral rolls," Damania alleged, pointing out that the deletions were particularly significant in districts such as Pune, Thane and Mumbai Suburban, which have large populations of workers, migrants and residents of economically weaker settlements. She questioned the reasons being cited for the deletions, including deaths, migration and duplicate registrations.

Damania also expressed concern over the process under which voters who failed to submit enumeration forms within the stipulated period could lose their place on the electoral rolls.

According to her, removing a citizen's name from the electoral roll without ensuring an accessible and transparent opportunity to raise objections raises serious questions about the protection of voting rights.

Damania demanded that the Election Commission immediately publish the complete list of deleted voters and conduct an independent and transparent inquiry into the exercise.

She further demanded an extension of the deadline for filing objections and urged authorities to simplify the process so that genuine voters can have their names restored without facing unnecessary difficulties.
