



Rs 5.5 crore distributed under PM-VBRY in DK

MP Capt Brijesh Chowta said that to generate employment and provide social security to employees and employers, ₹5.5 crore has been disbursed to 1,255 employees across 3,053 establishments under the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY) in Dakshina Kannada district.

He was speaking at the PM-VBRY incentive disbursement programme held on Friday at the Kanara Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI),

Mangaluru, organised by the Employees' Provident Fund Organisation (EPFO), Mangaluru in alignment with a national-

level event addressed by the PM Narendra Modi.

He added that the PMVBRY, launched in August 2025 by PM,

aims to generate employment for 3.5 crore people while strengthening social security for both employees and employers. Over the past decade of Modi governance, the government has strengthened financial inclusion through initiatives such as the Jan Dhan Yojana and Direct Benefit Transfer, ensuring subsidies reach beneficiaries without intermediaries and also working towards the vision of Viksit Bharat 2047.

Chowta further said that as an MP over the past two years, he has worked to build an eco-

system for employment generation in collaboration with industry bodies, including the KCCI.

During the programme, six employees and 14 establishments were symbolically handed over letters under the PM-VBRY scheme.

Mangaluru South MLA Vedavyas Kamath said that the PMVBRY scheme is designed to benefit around 15 lakh individuals with an outlay of ₹2,400 crore, helping guide youth towards productive employment and supporting national development.

Over 700 beneficiaries receive PM-VBRY employment benefits in Udupi

UDUPI: UDUPI-Chikkamagalur MP Kota Srinivas Poojary inaugurated the district-level national benefit distribution programme under the Pradhan Mantri Viksit Bharat Rozgar Yojana (PM-VBRY), a national Employment Linked Incentive scheme launched by the Union Government on Friday.



There was a live telecast of PM Modi presiding over the national benefit distribution programme under the scheme in Delhi, and benefits were distributed to eligible beneficiaries in Udupi on the occasion. Addressing the gathering, Poojary said that the scheme has been implemented to provide social security in various sectors and increase employment opportunities. He added, "As per the data, there are 42 crore labourers in the unorganised sector, and 29 crore are registered under the e-Shram portal. Under the scheme, 774 beneficiaries identified under Part A of the scheme will receive the assistance of ₹48,58,475, and 199 establishments under Part B will receive an assistance of ₹3.18 crore. This scheme will strengthen those who are contributing to the Atmanirbhar Bharat." ENS
